

Williamstown Congs Cricket Club Safe Transport Policy

This policy aims to provide a basis for the responsible use and/or non-use of alcohol by the *Williamstown Congs Cricket Club* and is seen as fundamental to the aims of the club.

To ensure the aims of the club are upheld, and that the club and its members manage alcohol responsibly, the following requirements will apply when alcohol is served by the club at the club or during a club function.

- Bar staff shall encourage members and visitors to make alternate safe transport arrangements if they are considered to exceed .05 blood alcohol concentration
- Telephone calls will be made free of charge to arrange a taxi or other transport
- Contact telephone numbers for taxi services will be displayed clearly
- In specific cases, where a designated driver who has been nominated by the club and that person has accepted the responsibility to drive others home safely, will be provided non alcoholic drinks and bar food free of charge by the club
- Bar servers will be provided non alcoholic drinks and bar food free of charge by the club
- Where available club transport will be provided to/from events
- A key register will be implemented
- Taxi vouchers will be considered as part of selected raffle prizes/player awards
